Throughout the journey, they will need to provide emotional and practical support for each other, building on a sense of common purpose and collaboration. 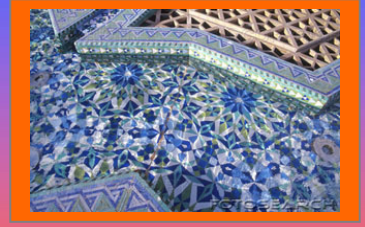

Time Required

- 5 days (for both options)

Sample Programme 1 – Climb Jebel Toubkal

- Day 1 – Fly to Marrakech, stay one night in a hotel
- Day 2 – Drive to the foothills of the mountains, where the road ends at Imlil. Walk 3,000 metres to base camp
- Day 3 - Walk up the south ridge of Jebel Toubkal – then back down
- Day 4 – Return to Marrakech, browse the open-air souks for rugs, leather, jewellery and watch the snake charmers
- Day 5 – Fly home from Marrakech

Sample Programme 2 - Sahara Safari

- Day 1 - Arrive Quarzazat, transfer to hotel and safari briefing
- Day 2 - Depart Quarzazat for a 2 hour journey by coach from where you self-drive out to the desert in 4X4's with a local guide. Stay in a Bedouin camp
- Day 3 – Trek across the desert via quad bike. Stay in a Bedouin camp
- Day 4 – Trek across the desert and through the sand dunes by camel. PM travel back to Quarzazat for a gala dinner at your hotel

Fast Facts

- Flying time from London – approx 4.5 hours
- Climate - dry for most of the year with some rain between November and March. Temperatures can be incredibly high in the southern and south eastern desert areas, yet very low, even freezing in the higher lying mountainous areas

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
