Time required

- 3-5 days (for both options)

Sample programme - Summer

- Day 1 - Fly into Ljubljana/Venice and transfer right in to the heart of the Soča Valley. Straight out to enjoy the beauty of the surroundings with a late afternoon raft down the river
- Day 2 - Climb a peak in Slovenia, lunch enjoying the breathtaking views at the top
- Day 3 - A morning caving expedition followed by an afternoon canyoning through the gorges
- Day 4 - A day on the river, first in kayaks, then on a raft before celebrating success
- Day 5 - Depart

Sample programme - Winter

- Day 1 - Fly into Ljubljana/Venice transfer to Kranjska Gora ski resort. Straight out that evening for a blast down the mountain on a single or double sledge. Traditional dinner and hotel accommodation
- Day 2 - Cross country skiing to an Alpine Lodge. Moonlit snow-shoe walk followed by a meal around a fire
- Day 3 - Early start to capture sun rise and ski down the mountain for breakfast. Afternoon caving expedition.
- Day 4 - Relax, low impact team exercises, lunch and depart

Fast Facts

- Flying time from London - approx 2 - 2.5 hours to Ljubljana or Venice with a short transfer
- Climate - pleasant in summer, cold in winter (down to -2C) and a fair amount of rain, most of it falling in March and April, October and November

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
